

## **Kekaha Federal Credit Union**

### **\$1,000 EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP**

#### **GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION**

Kekaha Federal Credit Union, in appreciation of its volunteers and loyal members is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to a qualified graduating high school senior. The credit union hopes that this will stimulate character, good citizenship and community leadership among its young members.

No limitation exists on the course of study and no employment obligations exist upon graduation either on the part of the credit union or the individual.

The following general rules apply:

1. Applicant must be a member or related to a member of Kekaha Federal Credit Union.
2. Must be a graduate of a recognized High School, or be graduating from one within four months from the date the application is submitted.
3. Must qualify for entrance to an undergraduate university, college or technical school in the United States of America through entrance examinations, or otherwise, for the fall term of the year the application is submitted.
4. Must be of sound mind and good character and intent on pursuing higher education.
5. Must properly fill out the application form provided and deliver or mail to Kekaha Federal Credit Union by May 18<sup>th</sup> of the year the applicant intends to attend or enter the university, college or technical school.
6. Must include a short essay (250 words or less) on the topic of "I deserve to be the recipient of the Kekaha Federal Credit Union Scholarship".

A committee composed of appointed members of the credit union, will select from among the applications the individual to be awarded the scholarship together with an alternative. Academic achievement, school and community activities, citizenship, character and financial need will be included in the considerations. This committee reserves the right to make no award should it feel that there has been no qualified applicant. Selections will be announced by the middle of May.
